Chiefs of Police Endorse Model Alarm Ordinance

The International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) recently passed a resolution that endorses the Model Alarm Ordinance as a tool for promoting "bests practices" to achieve a reduction in alarm dispatches and recommends the ordinance to its 31,000 members in 165 countries.

The ordinance, already in use in approximately 1,000 jurisdictions, was developed and tested in a cooperative effort between the Security Industry Alarm Coalition (SIAC), the IACP, and the National Sheriffs' Association.

The IACP resolution notes that the organization "recognizes the need for and value of enforcement tools and alarm management processes recommended in this Model Ordinance to achieve the desired reduction in alarm dispatches experienced by police agencies."







"When fully implemented and enforced, the Model Ordinance results in an approximate 60% reduction or more in alarm dispatches," said Stan Martin, SIAC Executive Director.

"The ordinance focuses on the very small percentage of systems that cause problems for law enforcement and takes into account that 85% of alarm systems generate no dispatches in any given year."



ECC – Enhanced Call Confirmation (previously called Enhanced Call Verification or ECV) – Two calls to different numbers to determine the cause of the alarm and whether a dispatch is required. Video, audio, and other means of confirmation are also included in the referenced ANSI CS-V01 standard in the Model Ordinance.

- Requiring Alarm Permits w/fees Registration for security systems is critical for the effective management of alarm programs.
- Limiting Free Responses/fines Setting reasonable fines for alarm dispatches can be a significant deterrent to the occasional offender. Allowing a maximum of two free responses before incurring fines is advisable. Utilizing one free response will yield even higher dispatch reductions.
- Ceasing Response to Chronic Abusers The industry supports stopping response to the chronic abusers while including a reasonable appeal and restoration process.
- Accepting Cancellations Allowing calls to be canceled if originating party verifies response is not needed.

"SIAC recognizes and supports the importance of a strong relationship between law enforcement and the private sector," said Martin. "As the industry's voice on electronic security issues, SIAC is committed to continuing its decades-long collaboration with leading law enforcement organizations such as the IACP to support our shared mission to protect lives and property."

IRS Notices, Liens, and Levies

The IRS collection division is recovering from pre-pandemic lockdowns and began sending out letters from the Automated Collection System function in June. They also restarted the income tax levy program in July. In addition, responsible officers continue to work on non-filer cases and are sending out notices and billing notices; however, their focus is primarily on egregious cases, such as high-income non-filers.

According to an IRS spokesperson "There's still a backlog of paper, and until that's cleared there will be people that efiled and mailed in their check, the check cleared, but they get notices saying they never paid. That's the downside of restarting the program. They have to do it because otherwise people will get complacent when they think there'll be no repercussion for not paying."

"The phone lines are still backlogged due to taxpayers not getting their refunds," he explained. "They have to go through manual processing, mostly for returns that had additional stimulus funds. Because of time constraints, the IRS didn't have time to fully reconfigure their computers to recalculate the additional credits due for the additional stimulus money.

This year continues to be unique and filled with issues. The IRS has hired over 3,200 employees to cover attrition and to increase staffing. As the IRS is attempting to reduce the backlog, the Austin and Fresno Service Centers have been tapped to help process Forms 941. As of mid-July, approximately 1.8 million forms have not yet been processed. For returns prior to 2021, 11,000 are still in inventory. These figures are for Form 941 returns — they don't include Form 940, or Form 941X amended returns. This problem is a large issue because many companies qualified for the Employee Retention Credit and are waiting for these returns to be processed so that they can receive their tax credit refunds.

If you receive a notice from the IRS that you believe is incorrect, don't have a heart attack, but don't disregard it either. Contact your tax professional or call us so that you can respond properly and timely. You should also call (or have your professional call) and request collections hold on your account. This will keep you from a surprise lien or levy and the accompanying headaches that come with them.
