Why Would California Suddenly Discourage Rooftop Solar Investment?

Politics in California is being manipulated to propel the current Governor, Gavin Newsome, to Washington

is nothing wrong with that; it is the American way. What is wrong is that he is preparing to gut the incentives for the installation of rooftop solar as part of an upcoming deal with the State's major public utilities, beginning in April of 2023. Meanwhile in Washington, the current President, also a Democrat, raised to 30%, the federal incentive for installation of Solar.

D.C. where he would like to become the next President. There

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is a state regulatory commission that is controlled by the Governor, and regulates Pacific Gas, and Electric, Southern California Edison, and San Diego Gas and Electric. Point of information: These new rules do not affect municipal utilities, such as the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power. These new rules will significantly lower the KWH pricing that these utilities pay to rooftop solar customers who sell their surplus energy to the public utilities. The CPUC vote was 5-0 in the affirmative and 4 of the 5 members were appointed by Governor Newsome. The public utilities have bitterly complained that rooftop solar homeowners who sell excess power to the utilities, are being subsidized by lower income homeowners who cannot afford rooftop solar.

It is difficult to realize how disingenuous the Public Utilities are until you understand how they make money. First, their cost for the power they create, or purchase is reimbursed by the customer; they do not make a profit on it. Their profit comes from the Grid. They build it, and they maintain it, and they make a profit from this investment. In effect rooftop solar

eliminates much of a need for a grid if there is a battery backup.

Whenever we face a major problem, we would be able to isolate it to one or two mini grids to control the problem. What happened in California with the wildfires would be unlikely to occur again. The loss of power to an entire state like Texas would be in the past.

If we use the grid for those non-sunlight hours, then they want to charge us for use of the grid. Currently the rules are that when a rooftop solar installation (with a battery) wants to cut their connection to the grid, they are prohibited by the CPUC. From a practical standpoint, if we wanted to eliminate the grid today, we couldn't do it because we don't have enough rooftop solar to replace it, and it will be quite some time before we do.

California has a stated goal of becoming a 100% renewable state by 2045. This may or may not be a realizable goal. The key to creating a serious drop in utility costs is to sharply reduce our commitment to build and maintain the grid. Many states,

particularly Texas and California, have single state grid systems which are regulated by state commissions. The cyber, weather and fire risks to grids in both states are major. Fire in California and freezing storms in Texas exemplify that. Rooftop solar and mini grids are the key to keeping these threats under control. If we are attacked by a cyber event in California, the last thing we want is to make it easy for the perpetrators. If everything is connected through a common grid, as it is now, we will pay the price.

If we lower the barriers for the installation of rooftop solar (with batteries) by providing incentives to everyone, especially lower income areas, that would also be an accelerant for the adoption of electric vehicles and other electric appliances. Technology is developing rapidly, especially in batteries and solar cells, resulting in lower prices today and even lower pricing tomorrow. This could dramatically shorten the time frame to retire most of the grid.

The wave of the future may be the mini grid, in some form, which will tie together neighborhoods, commercial centers, and small communities as self-standing suppliers of their own power, including battery storage, from rooftop solar and adjacent solar power sources. Whenever we face a major problem, we would be able to isolate it to one or two mini grids to control the problem. What happened in California with the wildfires would be unlikely to occur again. The loss of power to an entire state like Texas would be in the past. The more miles of

interdependent interconnected grid that we have, the more susceptible we are to catastrophic losses.

Once we understand the importance of rooftop solar and the opportunity it presents to the security industry, we will be able to accelerate the adoption of rooftop solar and help create a national solution to this crisis. A New Year and A New Legislature, 2023 Session Commences in Hartford

It is a new year and a new legislative session in Connecticut. The 2023 state legislative session officially commenced on Wednesday January 4th with all 187 state legislators, including 35 new lawmakers, being sworn into office, and Governor Lamont officially being inaugurated into his second term. and adjourns at midnight on June 7th.

Since 2023 is a "long" legislative session (January to June), legislators are permitted to introduce individual proposed bills on any topic, as opposed to being limited to bills relating solely to fiscal matters, as is the case in "short" session years. While the 2022 session saw approximately 1,000 pieces of legislation introduced, it is likely there will be well over 3,000 bills introduced in the 2023 session year.

In preparation for the session, as well as the influx of new lawmakers, legislative leadership was busy appointing new committee chairs in many instances. Some key legislative committees and personnel specific to some of CASIA's issues of interest inside the legislature include the following:

The General Law Committee, which oversees all matters relating to the Department of Consumer Protection, including home improvement and occupational licensing issues, among others, will once again be led by co-chairmen Rep. Mike D'Agostino (D-Hamden) and Sen. James Maroney (D-Milford). Also returning will be house ranking member Rep. Dave Rutigliano (R-Trumbull). There will also be a new senate ranking member to replace Sen. Kevin Witkos (R-Canton), who did not run for reelection.

The Labor & Public Employees Committee, which oversees all matters relating to the Department of Labor, including the unemployment compensation, workers' compensation, wages and industrial safety, among other issues, will once again be led by senate co-chair Sen. Julie Kushner (D-Danbury). She will be joined by her new house co-chair Rep. Quentin "Q" Williams



(D-Middletown), who moves to lead the Labor Committee after previously serving as co-chair of the Housing Committee. Rep. Tim Ackert (R-Coventry), who is an electrical contractor outside the legislature, will be the new house ranking member.

The legislature's powerful Finance, Revenue & Bonding Committee, which oversees all matters related to state finances, revenue, capital bonding, fees and taxation, will have some new leadership as well. Sen. John Fonfara (D-Hartford) returns as cochair but will be joined by new house co-chair Rep. Maria Horn (D-Salisbury). Horn previously served as co-chair of the Public Safety Committee. Ranking members will once again include Rep. Holly Cheeseman (R-East Lyme).

The Public Safety & Security Committee, which oversees all matters related to the state police, emergency preparedness, homeland security, fire marshals, fire safety and the state building code, among other issues, will see a new house co-chair with the appointment of Rep. Pat Boyd (D-Pomfret), who will join new senate co-chair Sen. Herron Gaston (D-Bridgeport). The new co-chairs will be joined by returning house ranking member Rep. Greg Howard (R-Stonington).

Finally, the Energy & Technology Committee, which oversees all matters related to the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection, energy planning and activities, as well as cable and telecommunications infrastructure, among other issues, will also be having some new leadership with house co-chair Rep. Jonathan Steinberg (D-Westport) being appointed to server alongside returning senate co-chair Sen. Norm Needleman (D-Essex). Rep. Bill Buckbee (R-New Milford) will be the new house ranking member.


